aptain Herb Browne was born in Mc-Kinney, Texas and although he claims the "Lone Star State" as his home, he is in fact an "Army Brat" and graduated from high school in Nuremburg, Germany.

He enlisted in the Navy after attending two years of college at Texas A&M University. Following a couple of years as a seaman, he was assigned to the Naval Aviation Training Command for Naval Flight Officer training and was designated and commissioned in March 1966.

Following A-6 bombardier/navigator training, Captain Browne reported to Attack Squadron Sixty-Five (VA-65) and deployed to WESTPAC aborad USS Kitty Hawk. In September 1969, Captain Browne reported to Attack Squadron 42 (VA-42), where he served as a flight instructor. In April 1972, he again reported to VA-65 and completed a Mediterranean deployment on board USS Independence.

Then he reported to the Office of Naval Operations, Director of Navy Program Planning (OP-090), as special assistant for Aviation and RDT&E. Captain Browne commanded USS Niagara Falls from June 1986 to January 1988 and completed another Indian Ocean
