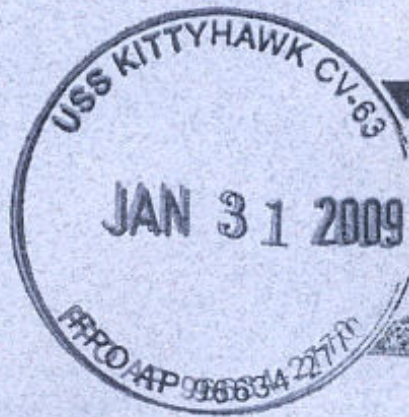

U.S.S. KITTY HAWK (CV-63)

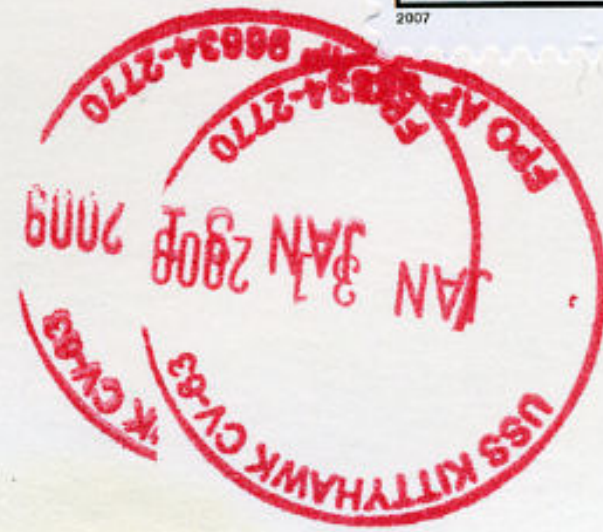

Great White Fleet Post Office Station



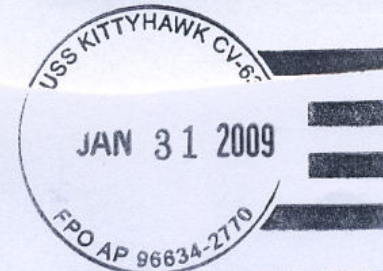

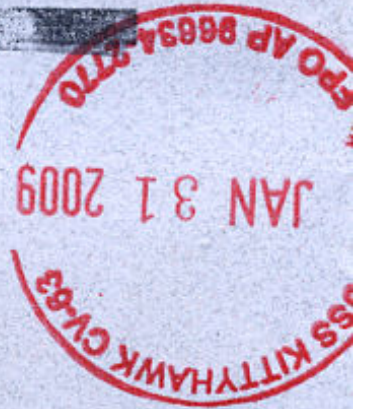
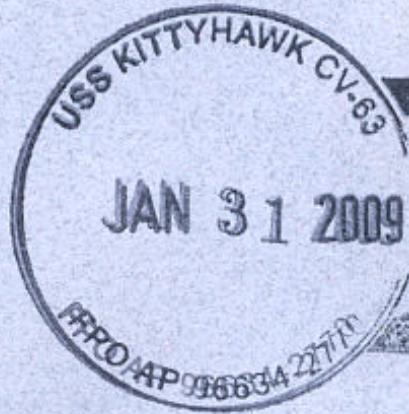
