The Gunnery Department is divided into Divisions each having certain duties and responsibilities. The Main Battery has three divisions; First Division manning Turret No. 1, Second Division manning Turret No. 2 and Third Division manning Turret No. 3.

The Secondary Battery is comprised of the five inch guns, which are manned by the Fourth and Fifth Divisions.

The 40MM are the responsibility of the Sixth and Seventh Divisions.

The Eighth Division and the Ninth (Marines) man the 20MM.

The Fire Control equipment comes under the cognizance of the "F" division.

Maintaining and operating the Radar equipment and providing well trained look-outs is the function of the "I" Division.

The "V" division is the Fall River air force.

In addition to these assigned fighting duties, each division has many collateral duties involving cleaning details, watches, deck duties and many other kindred shipboard occupations.
