



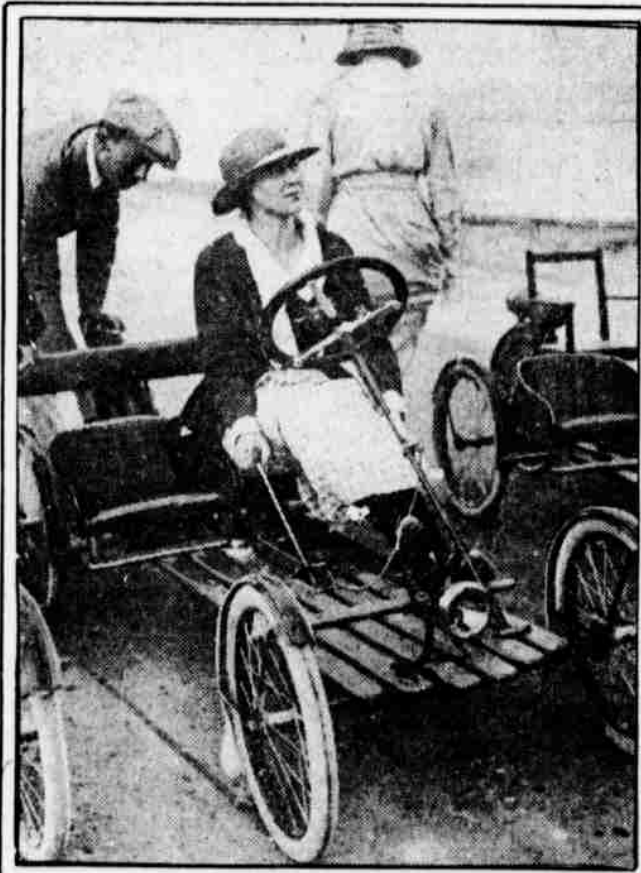

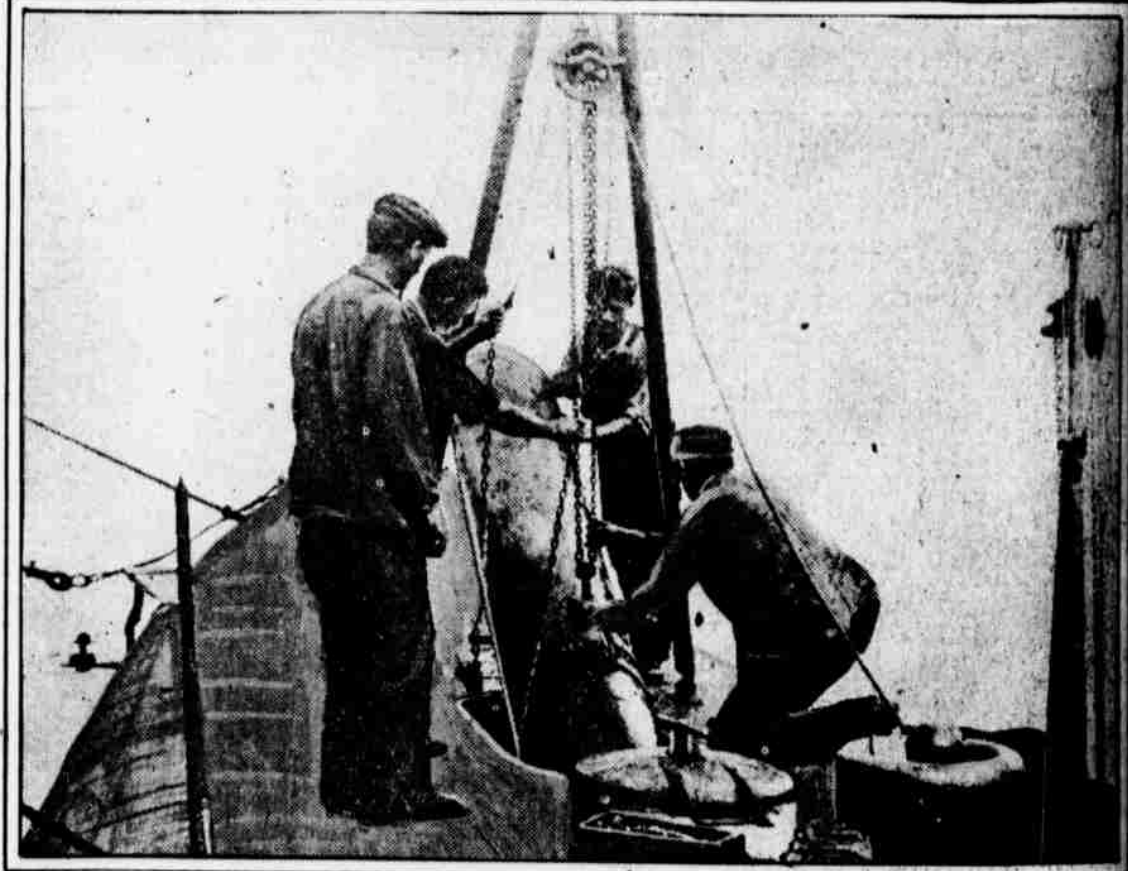

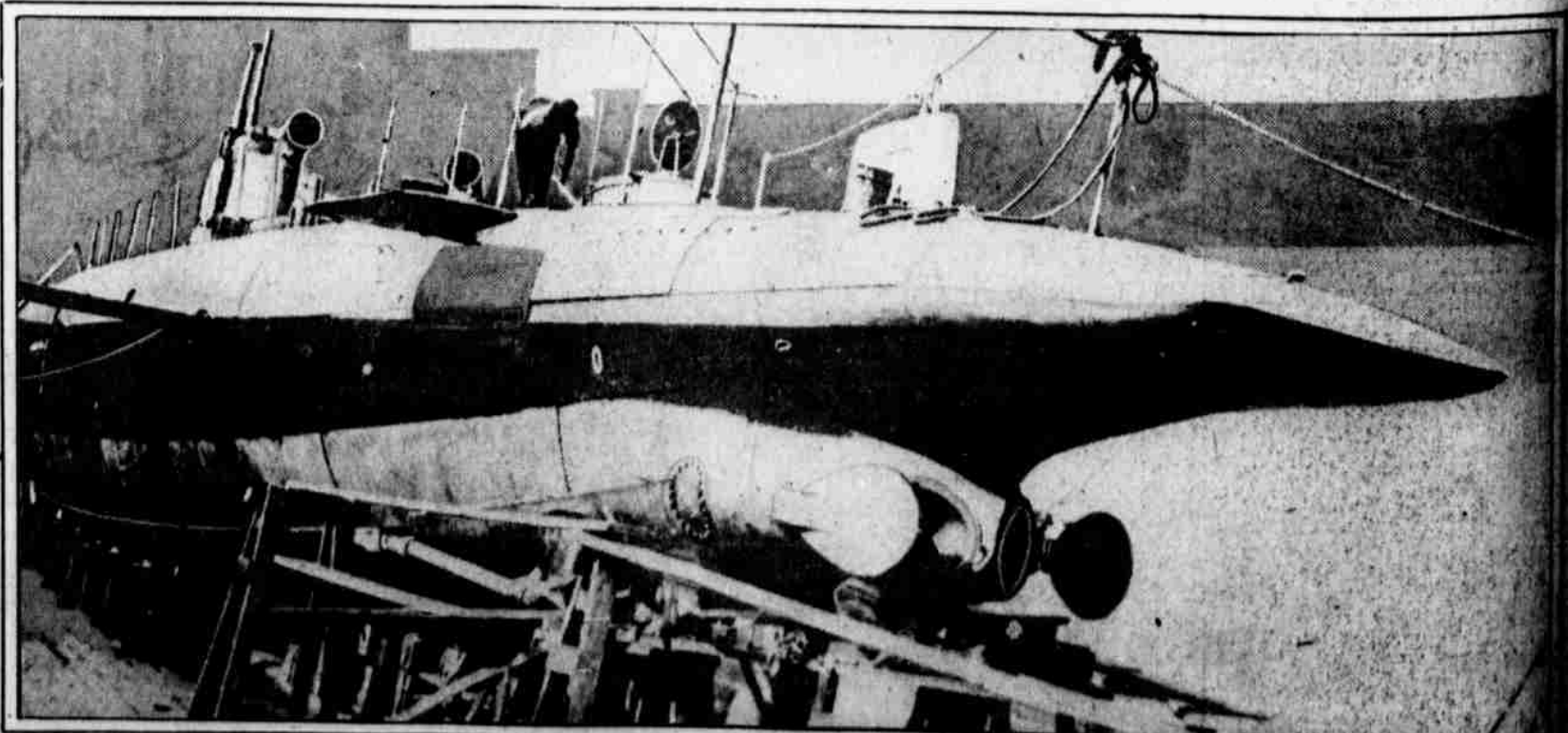


CREW ENTERING TORPEDO INTO FORWARD HATCH OF THE SUBMARINE G-4
