NOTE: During these exercises, conducted from 1 Warch 1945 to 7 Harch 1945 inclusive, scheduled to prepare this vessel for future amphibious operations, the vessel was assigned to Transport Squadron 18; Task Group 53.2, with Commander of the Task Unit on the U.S.S. BURLFIGH (APA 95). The beaches used, and the transport areas were off the Northeast coast of Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands, in the vicinity of Cape Esperance. On 12 larch received 2160 rounds 20 mm HET; 4320 rounds 20 mm HEI; 2000 rounds . 45 caliber ball, M1911, and 200 hand grenades, Mark II, on board from Fourth Marine Base Depot.

15 March: Anchored as before. 0615 underway in obedience to letter serial 00011 from T.G. 51.11.2 and ComTransRon 18 of 11 March 1945, in formation with TransDiv 52, in column with U.S.S. On 22 March and 26 March at 1945 and 1827 respectively, had Flash Red, Control Green alerts, at which times all guns were manned at General Quarters.
