

CHAPTER 43

STOREROOMS AND ISSUE ROOMS

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The spaces with definitely assigned stowage are as follows:

- (a) Bosn's. Stores - A-102AE - Main Deck, fr. 7-9, port.  
Rack of stowage shelves between fr. 8-9.
- (b) Chemical Defense Equipment stored in Windlass Machinery Room, A-102AE.
- (c) Galley Stores - A-104-1/2EL - Main Deck, fr. 17-19, port.
- (d) Engineer's Stores - C-102A - Main Deck, fr. 27-29, port.  
Stowage bins - outboard.  
Stowage shelves - inboard.
- (e) Machinery Spare Parts - C-204A - Hold Deck, frs. 27-29.
- (f) Refrigeration Machinery and Dry Provision Stores - Hold, fr. 17-19, port and starboard.  
Refrigeration Units are in forward part of compt. A-211-2AE at frame 17. Meat block and shelf unit in aft end of compartment.
- (g) General Stores - A-211-5AC - Hold, Fr. 17-19, stbd.
- (h) Ordnance Stores - C-101AT - Main Deck, fr. 27-29, stbd.
- (i) Vegetable Locker - A wooden vegetable locker, approximately 2-1/2' x 3' x 7', is provided on the Main Deck between frames 35-39, stbd.

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Four portable davits and whip hoists are provided at passing hatches on the Superstructure Deck. These hoists while mainly used for ammunition handling may be used for general handling of stowage.

Whip hoists using lifting eyes installed under the Superstructure Deck over hatchways, one in galley stores, (fr. 17, port), and one in passage, (fr. 30, stbd.), are also used for general handling of stowage.
