

DURING THE APPROACH, 8 SEPTEMBER, 1943 AT 1700, THE CREW WENT TO GENERAL QUARTERS UPON SIGNAL FROM THE U.S.S. BISCAYNE, FIRING BEING OBSERVED TO THE NORTHEAST, NEAR CAPRI. SHORTLY THEREAFTER, THE RIGHT FLANK OF THE CONVOY WAS ATTACKED UNSUCCESSFULLY BY A SINGLE ENEMY PLANE, ME-109, WHOSE BOMB MISSED A SMALL ESCORT CRAFT. THIS SHIP DID NOT FIRE.

DID NOT FIRE.

AT 2115, FLARES WERE SEEN OVER THE CONVOY INCREASING OVER A LARGE AREA. AT 2130, FLARES APPEARED OVERHEAD, FOLLOWED BY A DIVERBOMBING ATTACK IN THE AREA ABOUT THIS SHIP, WHICH WAS THEN FIRING HIGH AND TO PORT WITH OTHER VESSELS NEARBY. A LARGE BOMB OR STICK OF BOMBS FELL APPROXIMATELY FIFTY YARDS TO PORT, DOING NO DAMAGE TO SHIP OR PERSONNEL. THE ATTACK SUBSIDED AT 2150.

FROM 2330, REFERENCE VESSELS WILLIAM, QUEEN, AND CHARLLE, WERE PICKED UP AHEAD, AND LEFT TO PORT, AND DURING THIS LAST PART OF THE APPROACH, THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE WAS MAINTAINED ABOARD:

A LIGHT SUPPER, AND RETURNED TO STATIONS, THE BOAT CREWS CHECKING LINES AND READYING CRAFT FOR LOWERING.

9100: LICHTS EXTINGUISHED IN ALL TROOPS COMPARTMENTS.

9115: SCOUT BOAT, ENSIGN HOWE IN CHARGE, LOWERED AND AWAY.

9120: SIGNAL TO PROCEED TO BOAT STATIONS AND LOAD. THIS WAS DONE WITH FULL EQUIPMENT, IN 12 MINUTES FROM THE SIGNAL, ALL BOATS READY FOR LOWERING AT 9132.

9145: ARRIVED AT LOWERING AT 9132.

9255: LOWERED SMALL BOATS, ENSIGN ROTH IN CHARGE.

BETWEEN ARRIVAL AT THE LOWERING POINT AND DESPATCHING LCVP'S, THE FORMATION OF ASSAULT LST'S WAS UNDER FIRE FROM SHORE BATTERIES TO THE NORTHWARD. SHRAPNEL BURSTS EXPLODED OVER THE SHIPS IN THE VICINITY BUT THE LOWERING AND DESPATCHING OF SMALL BOATS WAS NOT IMPEDED. RETURN FIRE WAS MADE BY SUPPORTING NAVAL CRAFT TO NORTHWARD.

DURING THE HALF-HOUR \$\text{0415}\$ TO \$\text{0445}\$ ALL SMALL BOATS BETHENED TO THE

APPROACH, THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE WAS MAINTAINED ABOARD:

A LIGHT SUPPER, AND RETURNED TO STATIONS, THE BOAT CREWS CHECKING LINES

BETWEEN ARRIVAL AT THE LOWERING POINT AND DESPATCHING LCVP'S, THE FORMATION OF ASSAULT LST'S WAS UNDER FIRE FROM SHORE BATTERIES TO THE FORMATION OF ASSAULT LST'S WAS UNDER FIRE FROM SHORE BATTERIES TO THE NORTHWARD.
