> LCT's of Group 66 operating in Lingayen Gulf, Luzon, P. I.

1-30 Sept. During this period LCT's of Group 66 carried on operations consisting of unloading cargo snips, and back-loading cargo ships in Damortis, Dagupan, White Beach, and San Fernando, Luzon, P. I., area. LCT(6) 1069 was inspected and repaired in drydock at Subic Bay, Luzon, P. I., from 22-24 Sept.
