**FIVE ENTERED PLEAS  
OF GUILTY YESTERDAY**

CRIMINAL COURT FOR AN-  
DERSON MOVES ON

**THE SECOND DAY**

Three Shaw's Were Acquitted On  
the Charge of Assault and  
Battery on Strickland

The second day of the Court of General Sessions for Anderson county succeeded in dispatching more business than on the first day and considerable progress was made on the docket.

When court convened yesterday morning the case of W. M. Gentry charged with violating the dispensary laws was first completed. This case was in progress when court adjourned Monday evening. The jury returned a verdict yesterday morning of guilty.

The next case taken up was that of John William Shaw, Eugene Shaw and Carl Shaw, charged with assault and battery upon the person of G. W. Strickland. This case occupied the attention of the court throughout all of the forenoon and part of the afternoon. The jury returned a verdict of not guilty.

In the case of S. M. Bass, charged with selling whiskey, the jury returned a verdict of not guilty.

The following items of guilty were entered yesterday. Bill Whitford, George Whitford and Sam Whitford, a charge of manufacturing whiskey; they were sentenced to a fine of \$100 each in six months in jail.

Henry Lee entered a plea of guilty to the charge of obtaining money under false pretenses and was sentenced to seven months in jail.

Newt Key pleaded guilty to a charge of selling whiskey and was sentenced to a fine of \$100 or six months in jail. The following true bills were returned yesterday by the grand jury:
