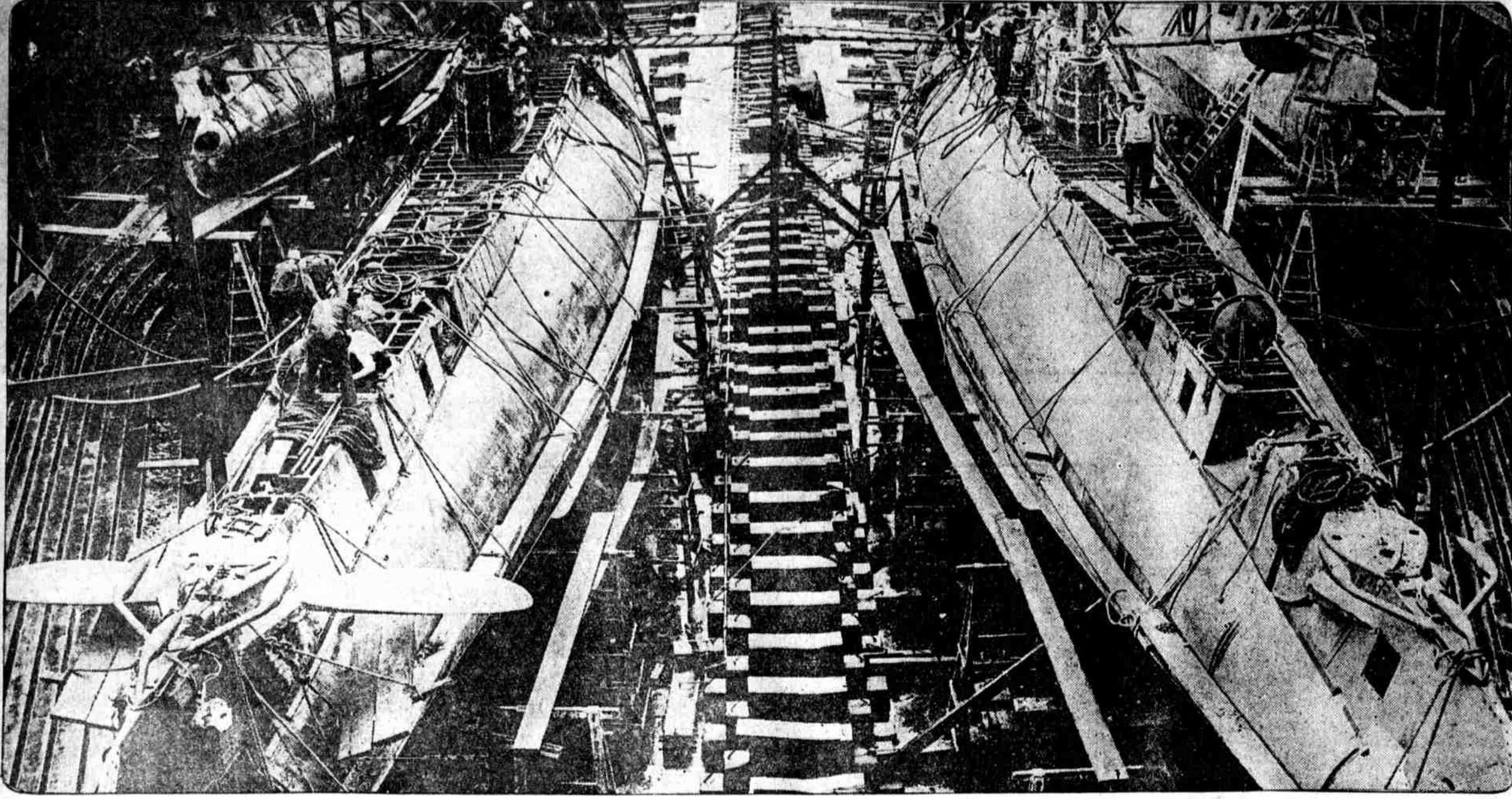


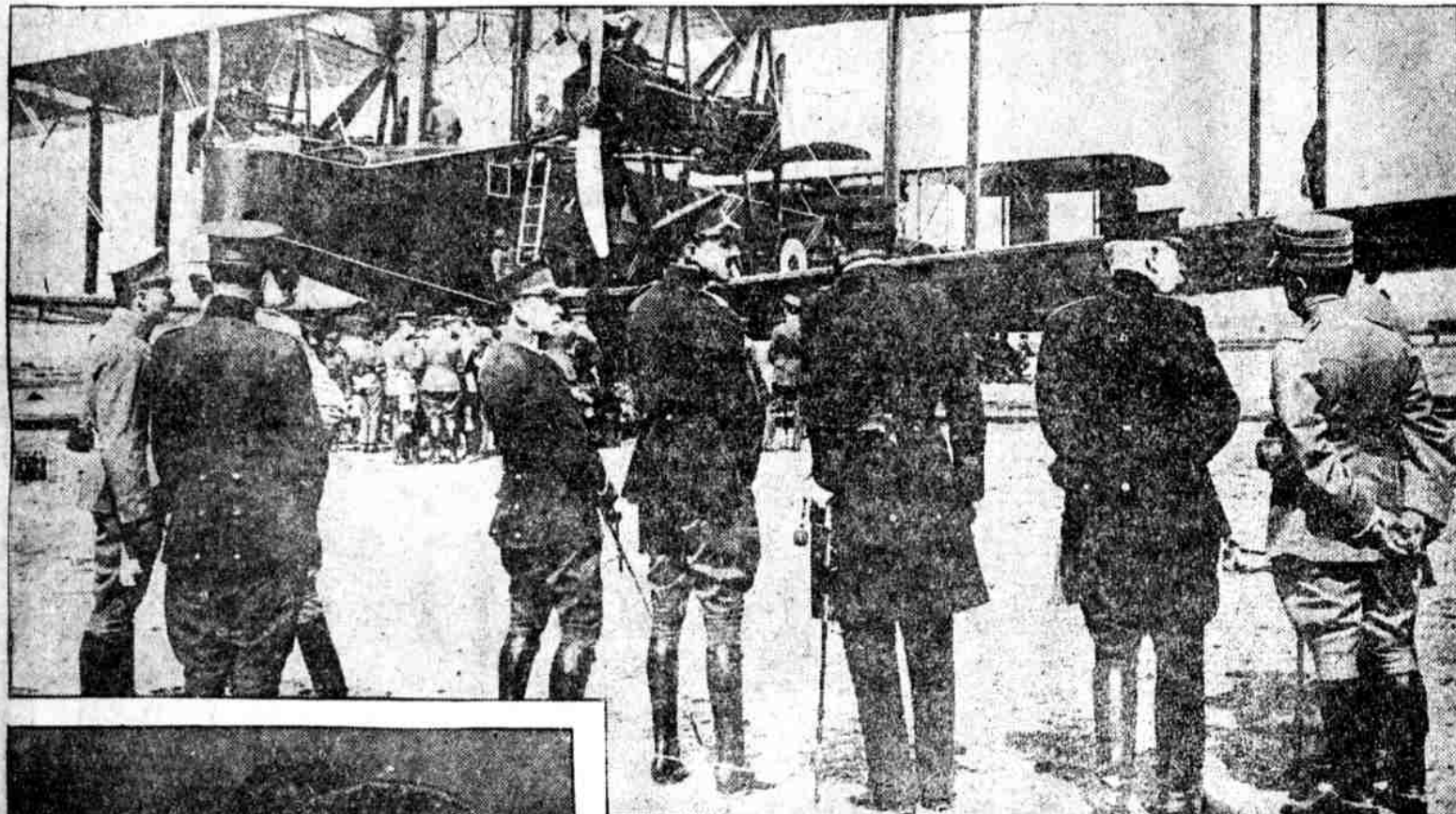
U. S. Submarines in League Island Drydock : Media's Peace Jubilee : London-Madrid Airplane



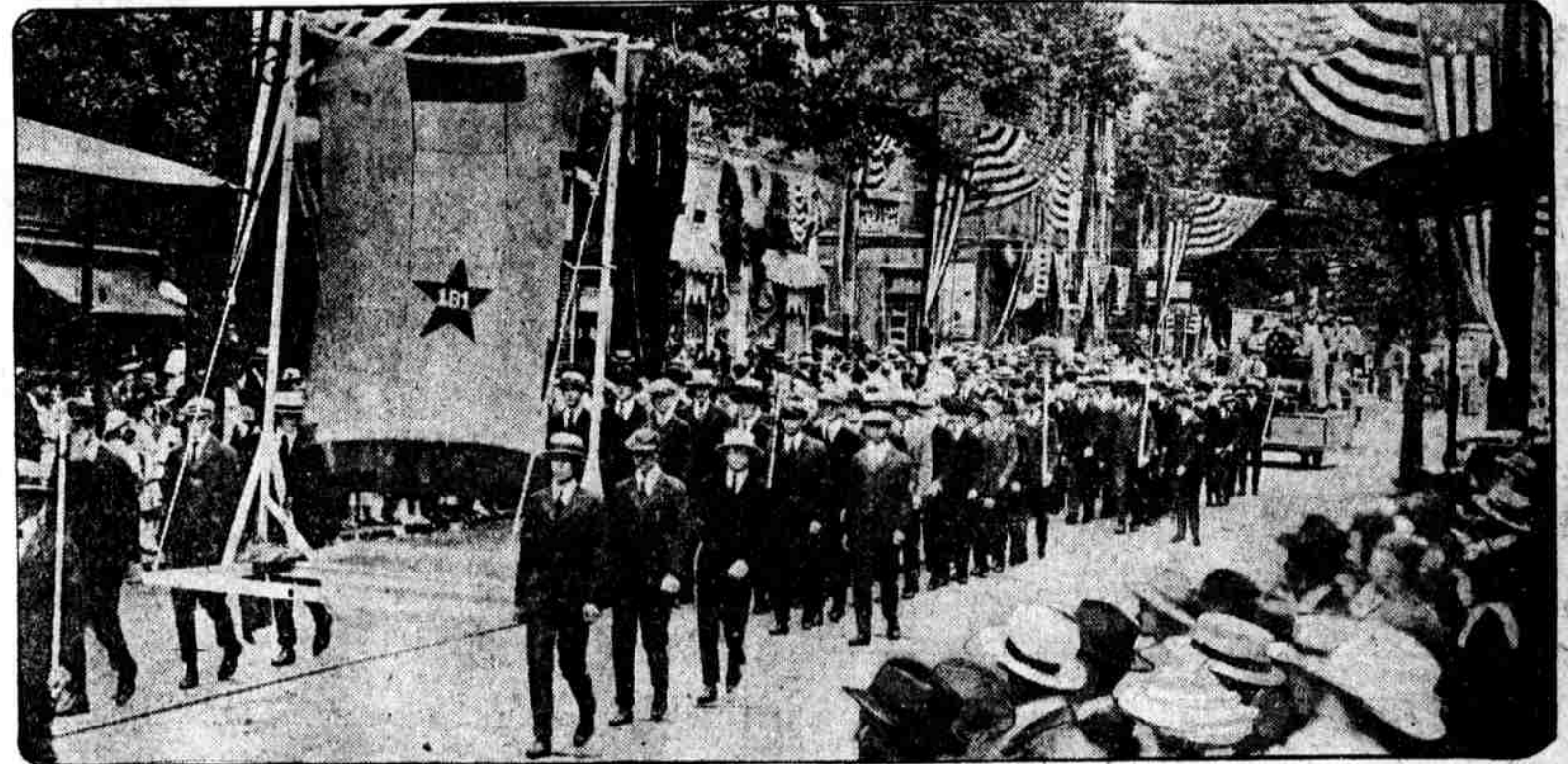

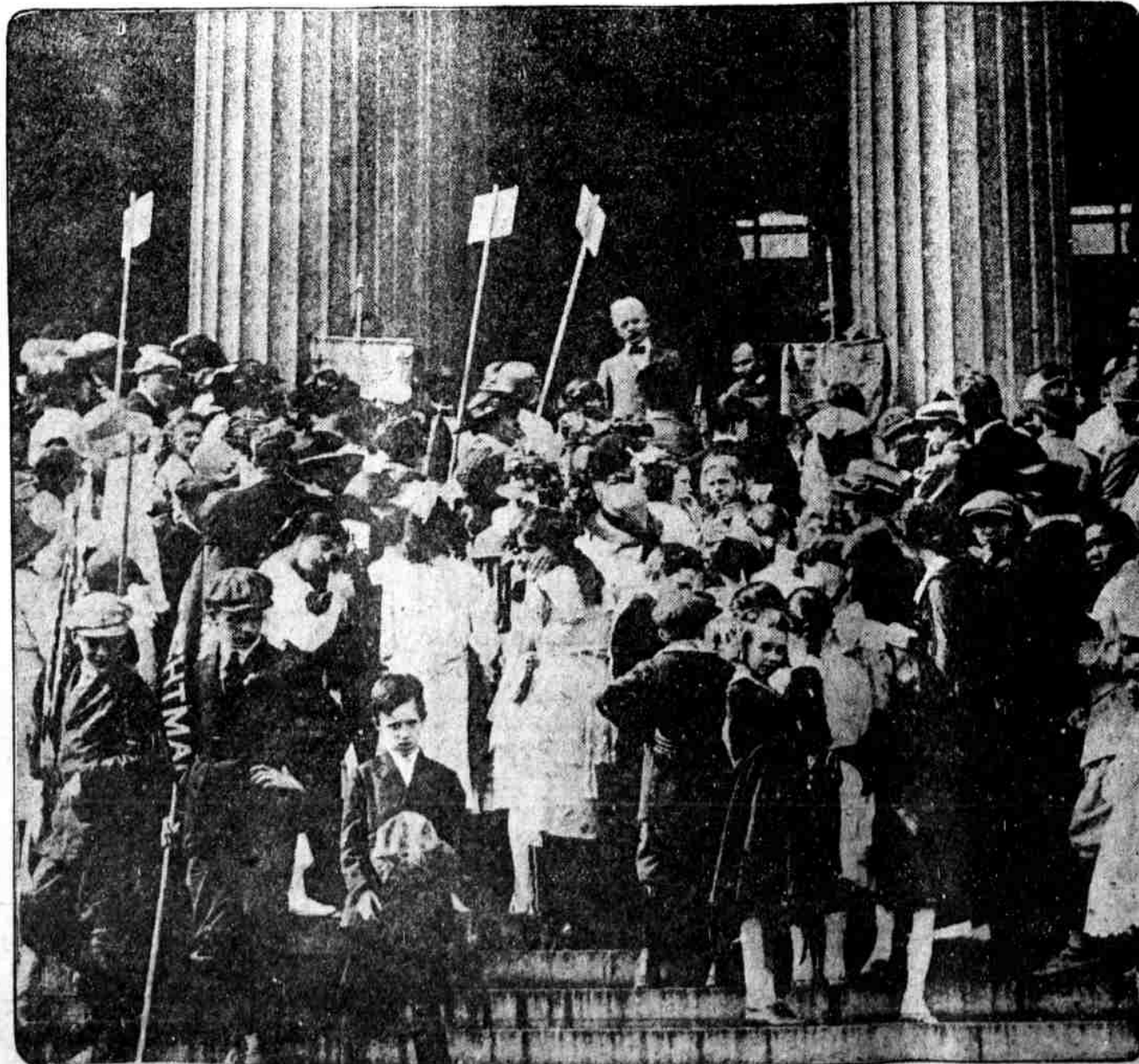
KING ALFONSO of Spain, fourth from right, inspecting the new Handley-Page machine which has just completed a flight from London to Madrid with twelve passengers.
