Lieutenant Commander E.V. CRARR assumes command of USS BASHAW following a tour of duty with COMSUBPAC at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii where he served as assistant Polaris Operations Officer. Lieutenant Commander CRABB a 1953 graduate of the California Maritime Academy at Vallejo, California has served on the USS WISEMAN DE-667, the USS CAT-FISH SS-339, as Executive Officer and Operations Officer of the USS REMORA during her FRAM conversion in 1962 and then as Executive Officer USS GRAYBACK SSG-574 until her decommissioning in 1964.

Commander E.W. WILSON a 1952 NROTC graduate of the University of Texas, assumed command of USS BASHAW in November 1964. Previously he served on the USS McCOY REYNOLDS DE-440. the submarines USS REMORA SS-487, USS MAPERU SS-376. USS SPINAX SS-489, and as Executive Officer USS SEGUNDO SS-398. Commander WILSON has served on the staffs of COM-CORTDIV 112, COMSUBRON FIVE, Commander Thirtheenth Naval District and as Officer in Charge of a Mobile training team of the Turkish submarine

Upon detachment, Commander WILSON reports for duty under instruction to the Armed Forces Staff College at Nor-folk, Virginia.
