Commissioning Program



1. Ship's company falls in aft at commissioning parade.
2. Upon arrival of Commandant bugler sounds attention.
3. Prospective Commanding Officer reports he is ready to proceed with commissioning.
4. The invocation is given by the Chaplain.
5. The Captain of the Yard orders the Prospective Commanding Officer to place the ship in commission.
6. All hands face the colors and salute while the National Anthem is played and the colors and commission pennant are raised.
7. The Commanding Officer reads his orders to the Commandant and formally accepts command of the ship.
8. The watch is posted.
9. The flag of the Admiral is broken and honors are rendered (if on board).
10. The Commanding Officer introduces the Commandant or representative, or Surgeon General.
11. At the conclusion of the Commandant's speech retreat is sounded and the ceremony is completed.

U. S. S. REPOSE (AH-16)



THE U. S. S. REPOSE is sponsored by the New York Chapter American Red Cross. The Repose is one of a class of six new hospital ships to be completed in the New York area. The ship is the first in our Navy to bear this name, which is in the tradition of the previous Navy hospital ships, Relief (AH-1), Solace (AH-5), Bountiful (AH-9), Samaritan (AH-10) and Refuge (AH-11).



Light refreshments will be served aboard ship immediately following the commissioning ceremonies.



The ship will be open for inspection after commissioning until 1400.
