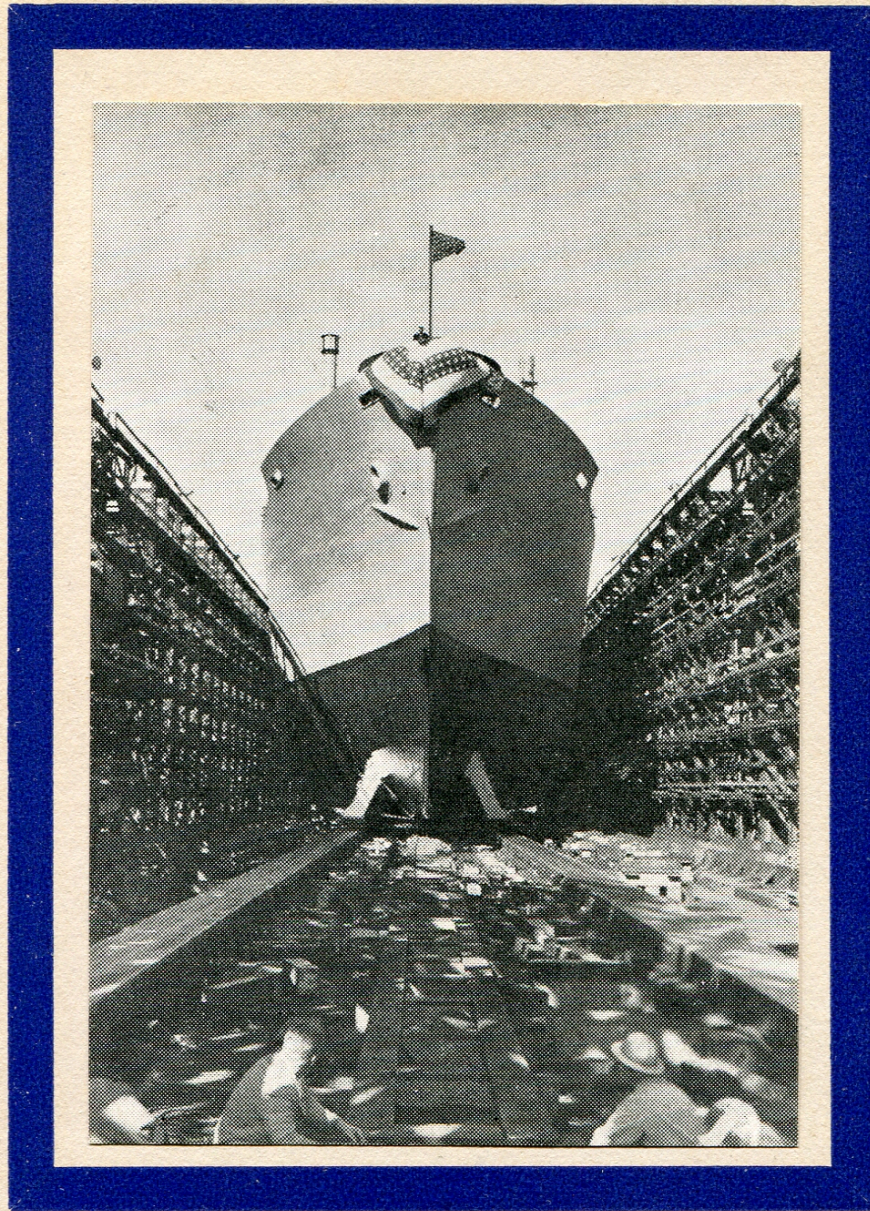

S. S. Clinton

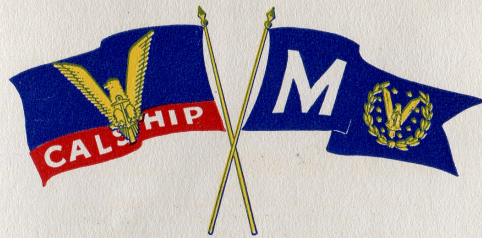
The Attack Transport being built by Calship for the U. S. Maritime Commission and the Navy are named by the Commission for counties in the various States of the Union. The ship being launched today, S. S. CLINTON (our 28th Transport) honors counties in the States of Indiana, Ohio, Mississippi, Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania and Kentucky. Keel laid September 28, 1944.

Calship

Second largest emergency shipyard in America, with 14 ways and 10 outfitting docks, California Shipbuilding Corporation has delivered to the U. S. Maritime Commission 306 Liberty Ships, 30 Liberty-type Tankers, 32 Victory Ships and 13 Attack Transports. Fourteen more Transports have been launched. Today's ship is the 396th to be launched at this yard, an average of one every 70 hours since September 24, 1941. Present contracts call for 63 additional Victory Ships and 2 more Attack Transports.
