I ASK THAT THE DISCIPLINE WHICH HAS SERVED SO WELL IN PRESERVING THIS DEMOCRACY IN HOURS OF NATIONAL CRISIS BE MAINTAINED TO THE END THAT NOTHING WILL MAR THE RECORD OF ACCOMPLISHMENT AND GLORY THAT NOW BELONGS TO THE NAVY, MARINE CORPS AND COAST GUARD.
