Reference: (a) Pac Flt Letter 91-44 dated 19 January 1944

1. In accordance with instructions contained in above reference (a), the following casualty report is submitted. The casualties occurred 1 April 1945 on U.S.S. LCI (M) 807 1800 yards off west beach of Okinawa Island while supporting landing of troops, cause by explosion of our mortar shell on board ship, the shell having stuck in the barrel.
