Narrative Report of Operations 5-17 June 1944. Subjects

This vessel assigned to Follow-Up Convoy Group 125.12, Red LST Unit No.2, Commander W. S. Rlair, USNR in tactical command.

2. 0855, 5 June 1944: Underway. Condition 3, with all hands off watch sleeping and eating at battle stations.
1646, 6 June 1944: Anchored in transport area, Utah Sector.

Lowered 4 boats for detached duty on far shore.

1025, 7 June 1944: TMS 352 alongside and transferred 19 casualties from deck to deck.

1048, 7 June 1944: Hoisted 10 casualties by sling from LCVP. 1118, 7 June 1944: AM 124 alongside and transferred 19 casualties

from deck to deck. 1225, 7 June 1944: ICT 522 alongside and transferred 53 casualties

1320, 7 June 1944: Married to LCT 585 and transferred first troops and vehicles.

1554, 7 June 1944: Married to LCT 809 and transferred second group of personnel and vehicles.

Fueled, watered, and provisioned 2 LCT's and several LCM's during day.

1617, 7 June 1944: Underway to close beach.

1730, 7 June 1944: Anchored 2000 yards off Red beach, Utah Sector. 1815, 7 June 1944: Commenced unloading via LCT 809.

1850, 7 June 1944: Enemy planes strafed beach. Shortly thereafter explosions on beach, Utah Sector, presumed from enemy bombers, and then smoke trail observed by Commanding Officer in arc from inland culmina-

ting in explosions near beach. Selieved to be rocket.

1855, 7 June 1944: Hoisted 2 sinking LCVP's for salvage.

1855, 7 June 1944: Unloaded casualties from Dukw's via sling.
2209, 7 June 1944: Completed unloading. Shifted anchorage to
vicinity of control vessel awaiting orders.

O511, 8 June 1944: Received casualties and survivors of DD638 via aling from LCVF's.

0606, 8 June 1944: Completed loading casualties.

1527, 8 June 1944: Underway in Convoy for Portland.

0841, 9 June 1944: Moored to hard S2, Portland.

0854, 9 June 1944: Commenced transferring casualties

1005, 9 June 1944: Finished transferring of casualties.

1137, 9 June 1944: Commenced loading. 1430, 9 June 1944: Pinished loading.

0906, 10 June 1944: Underway for far shore. 2038, 10 June 1944: Anchored in Omaha Sector.

2120, 10 June 1944: Shifted anchorage to vicinity Dog white

beach, Omaha Sector.

0320, 11 June 1944: Underway for beach. 0350 - 0534, 11 June 1944: Intermittent attacks from enemy aircraft. 0357, 11 June 1944: Opened fire on 2 planes in range, No hite observed by this vessel.

0520, 11 June 1944: Beached in Dog white beach, Omaha Sector. 0714, 11 June 1944: Commenced unloading. 1221, 11 June 1944: Retracted. Anchored in assembly area. 0556, 12 June 1944: Underway.
