

TIMOTHY P. DUGAN, USN

LIEUTENANT UNITED STATES NAVY

LIEUTENANT DUGAN was born in Washington, D. C. on 25 August 1939. In 1957 he was appointed to the U.S. Naval Academy by the Secretary of the Navy. LT DUGAN was commissioned an Ensign on 7 June 1961. After serving for two months aboard the destroyer USS BROWN (DD-546) in the Operations Department, he was ordered to the USS BUCHANAN (DDG-14) precommissioning detail. He served aboard the BUCHANAN as MPA and Gunnery Assistant. In January 1964 LT DUGAN relieved as Executive Officer and Navigator on board the USS SUMMER COUNTY (LST-1148). In November 1965 he was ordered to the Philadelphia Group of the Atlantic Reserve Fleet as Prospective Commanding Officer of the USS COCONINO COUNTY (LST-603), which was then being reactivated. He assumed command when she was recommissioned on 8 June 1966 at the Philadelphia Naval Shipyard.

LT DUGAN is married to the former Lorraine Alice KAZIUN of Seaford, New York. They have two daughters, Lisa and Allison.

STEVEN L. TURNER, USN

LIEUTENANT UNITED STATES NAVY



LIEUTENANT TURNER was born on 8 June 1939 in Danville, Virginia. He attended public schools in Danville, and in 1957 was appointed to the United States Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point, New York, by Congressman William M. TUCK. Following graduation and commissioning as Ensign, USNR, on 31 July 1961, LT TURNER began his Naval career. He served on the USS CONWAY (DD-507) as MPA and DCA until November 1962 when he entered the Destroyer School at Newport, Rhode Island. Following graduation from Destroyer School, LT TURNER became Engineer Officer of USS HOLDER (DD-819). Following service on USS HOLDER (DD-819) and augmentation into the regular Navy, LT TURNER was assigned to the NROTC Unit at the University of South Carolina where he taught Naval Engineering and Naval Weapons. While at the University, LT TURNER earned a Masters Degree in Mechanical Engineering. In April 1968, he received orders to command USS COCONINO COUNTY (LST-603).

LT TURNER is married to the former Louise MOUGEOT of Montereal, Canada.
