OPERATIONAL RECORD OF USS LST 762 3 NOVEMBER 1950 - 31 AUGUST 1954

The Following summary of ship's movements was developed from copies of deck logs of the USS LST 762 obtained from the National Archives. The ship was re-commissioned at Astoria, OR on 3 November 1950 because of the outbreak of the Korean War.
