1. The following are hereby detached from their present duty with the Amphibious Training Command, U.S. Atlantic Fleet and from such other duties as may have been assigned them, and when directed Lieut. 2. Upon arrival at Ambridge, Pa., you will report to the Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Dravo Corp., Neville Island, Pittsburgh, Pa., by letter.

3. The Disbursing Officer, Receiving Station, NOB., Norfolk, Va., is hereby authorized and directed to issue the necessary troop movement and baggage transportation in the execution of these orders.

4. Reimbursement will be on a per diem basis in accordance with Article 2501-4(d) NTI, except while traveling with troops.

5. The original and one copy of these orders must be forwarded to the Bureau of Naval Personnel for approval upon the completion of the travel.

6. The records and accounts of the officers and men in your charge are closed out and handed you herewith for safe delivery to your new command.

7. You are warned that indulgence in intoxicating liquor and discussion of Naval affairs by you or members of your draft while enroute will result in disciplinary action.
