1. D Day: Arrived at transport area at 0430. Left transport area at 0630 which was designated time. Passed reference vessel 080E at 0710. Passed reference vessel CHARLIE at 0740. Unable to find ABLE, so proceeded as to time. Beached at 0817. Sniper fire was encountered. Minor underwater obstacles were found to have punctured small holes in starboard bow. Upon retracting, proceeded to transport area as previously directed to unload LST's. At 2200 began to unload liberties.
