1. In compliance with reference (a), the following
War Diary for this command is submitted:

1 June 1945: WAR DIARY of USS LCT(6) GROUP 66, Flotilla 22,
Seventh Amphibious Force, Seventh Fleet.
Composed of LCT(6)'s 1038, 1039, 1067, 1068, 1069,
1070, 1071, 1072, 1073, 1074, 1076. Flagship of
LCT (6) Group 66 - U.S.LCT(6) 1071.
LCT's of Group 66 operating in Lingayen Gulf,
Luzon, P. I.

1 - 30 June 1945: During this period, LCT's of Group 66 carried on
operations, consisting of unloading cargo ships,
and back-loading cargo ships in Damortis, Dagupan,
White Beach, and San Fernando, Luzon, P.I., area.
Dry-docking facilities being available through
25 June, LCT's 1068, 1070, 1072, and 1073, were
thoroughly checked and required repairs were made.
During the month other LCT's under operational
control of Group 66 were as follows: LCT's 721,
726, 727, 728, 731, 1024, 1032.
Material Inspections were made on LCT's as
follows:
