1. In compliance with reference (a), the following
War Diary for this command is submitted:

1 March 1945: WAR DIARY of USS LCT(6) GROUP 66, Flotilla 22,
Seventh Amphibious Force, Seventh Fleet. Composed
of LCT(6)'s 1038, 1039, 1067, 1068, 1069, 1070,
1071, 1072, 1073, 1074, 1076. Flagship of LCT(6)
Group 66 - U.S. LCT(6) 1071.
LCTs of Group 66 operating in Subic Bay, Luzon, P.I.
Exceptions: LCTs 1038, 1039, operating at Lingayen
Gulf, Luzon, P.I.

1 - 31 March 1945: During this period, LCTs of Group 66 carried
on operations, consisting of unloading cargo
ships, and working for Destroyer Squadrons and
Cruiser Divisions, unloading and carrying sup-
plies. Dry-docking facilities being available
LCTs were thoroughly checked and required re-
pairs were made.
Other LCT's under operational control of Group
66 as follows: LCTs 719, 721, 722, 724, 726,
729, 1063, 1209, 1210, 1222, 1255, 1258, 1259,
1262.
