1. In compliance with Reference (a), the following
War Diary for this command is submitted:

1-5 May 1945: LCT's of Group 66 carried on operations consist-
ing of unloading cargo vessels for the army at
White Beach #2, Lingayen Gulf, Luzon, P.I. Other
LCT's operating under operational control of
Commander LCT Group 66: 723, 735, 1035, 1148,
1149.

5-31 May 1945: Operations continued at White Beach #2 and Da-
mortis, Luzon, P.I., backloading cargo vessels
for army and making shuttle runs to San Fernando,
Luzon, P.I.

25 May 1945: 1600- LCT's 1039, 1069, 1071 (F) got underway and
formed column with LCT 1071 as guide. Destination:
LCT 1071-Bangui Point; LCT 1039-Dirique Inlet;
LCT 1069-Bacarra, Northern Luzon, P.I. Movement
Order 4-45, dated 25 May 1945.

28 May 1945: 1148- LCT's 1039, 1069, 1071 (F) anchored in
Lingayen Gulf, P.I.

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
